February 11, 2021

Meeting called to order by Bill Schroeter at 5:36 PM.

26 people were in attendance.

Ed Gregory opened by explaining the background and that Consolidated Communications was selected as part of the RFP process. In order to cover the costs of Broadband Internet, the Town would vote at Town Meeting on March 13th at 12 noon AT THE UNITY SCHOOL to pursue a Bond via a Warrant Article. The cost of the Bond is not passed on through taxes. Consolidated Communications would collect a monthly recovery/subscription fee from anyone that subscribes to Broadband and use toward repaying the Bond. Ed introduced Jeff McIver and Mike Cannon of Consolidated Communications.

Jeff and Mike presented on a plan to bring Broadband Internet/fiber optic into the Town of Unity and explained that the current system of copper and DSL will be remaining at this time. Fiber optic provides high speed "glass" broadband internet to residents and those that wish to sign up for the service can and others are not required to. Mike addressed past customer service concerns and that going forward they are working on those concerns and will be providing a dedicated customer service team for Broadband. Mike and Jeff offered their contact information/business cards for anyone with a current service concern so that they can work to help rectify.

With this system what download speed you purchase is the same upload speed. Currently offer 25/3 Mbps, they will offer 50, 250 and 1 Gig for broadband customers.

Mike explained the system installation and components of the install.

If Consolidated does not have enough broadband customers they are still required to make payments to the Town to cover the Bond payments. The Bond is being paid by CCI, not the Town and CCI is not allowed to make a profit off of a Bond. Every few years CCI and the Town will reassess the Bond balance owed vs. the recovery/subscriber fee (now \$12/month to those who sign up for Broadband only) to see if can be reduced. It can never go up, but can go down.

The total project cost is \$2,512,110. Consolidated is contributing \$762,735 to that cost and the Town would Bond for \$1,749,375. The Bond amount (\$1.7M) is being covered by CCI. They pay the Town and the Town pays down the Bond.

CCI advised that if approved and Bond issued, customers who sign up for Broadband could be on by the beginning of next year. They will begin ordering equipment upon Bond issue. CCI is supplying a website so customers can watch the progress.

CCI took Q&A and answered questions about the Bond, to clarify that they supply the funds to the Town and the Town repays the Bond.

Heather Bliss presented on the Public Benefits Findings. A vote to approve those Public Benefits was taken and passed and a vote was unanimous to proceed to the Bond Vote at March Town Meeting.

Bill closed the meeting at 6:55 PM

Bill Schroeter called the Bond Hearing to order at 7:00 PM

11 people were in attendance.

Bill read the Warrant Article. This will be voted on at Town Meeting by ballot and open for one hour.

Those in attendance questioned the amount in the Warrant Article read.

Heather Bliss, Broadband Internet Committee, explained there was a total project cost, Bond amount to be requested and the contribution amount from the Provider included in the verbiage of the Warrant. She asked to present the Bond Hearing information and answer any further questions that followed.

Background on the Committee and Selectmen's work to provide Broadband to the Town was explained. CCI was selected as the Provider based on their completed RFI, RFP and offering an experience and Town wide solution. NHEC was met with and it was determined that they were very new to the area of Broadband and therefore not able to meet the Town's needs.

The Town does not incur costs for the Bond. CCI is also covering our legal fees as well as will be responsible to pay the Bond back (via payments to the Town).

The costs that CCI pays to the town will in part be paid through collection of a recovery/subscriber fee of \$12/month from Broadband customers. Anyone not subscribing to Broadband does not pay this fee. CCI will begin paying back the Bond whether they have collected the fee or not; therefore, it is to their benefit to build the infrastructure and get customers up and running sooner rather than later.

Project Cost is \$2,512,110, Amount of Bond that Town would request is \$1,749,375, Contribution from CCI is \$762,735, Cost to Tax Payers = \$0

Securing a Bond allows the Provider to begin the work more quickly than if they had to budget for a project over a number of years. Residents need reliable internet, now, not later. Many are now working from home permanently or long term and students need to be able to do remote learning now.

Town will apply for the Bond through the New Hampshire Municipal Bond Bank (NHMBB). The bond is a 20 year term. At the end of the term, the Town owns the lines and can determine if they are satisfied with CCI and wish to have them maintain the network or go with another provider.

Ed made a motion to sign the minutes for Dec. 13th & 20th Bill 2nd All in favor.




